Need A Good Contractor or Have A Good Contractor To Refer?

The Alliance of Reston Clusters and Homeowners (ARCH) has a Procurement Referrals Database on their website. The purpose of the database is to provide a location to report contractors with whom you/your cluster have had a positive performance experience. It is not, nor is it intended to be, an exhaustive listing of vendors. Vendors are identified only if a member voluntarily inputs the information and is willing to serve as a positive reference. To access the database, go to www.restonarch.org and click on the Procurement link to get to the Procurement Referrals Database. When prompted for username enter "member" and enter "roosevelt" for the password.
